

PADI ADVANCED OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE

Dive2go staff has been training new divers through to Instructors in Australia & the South Pacific for more than 25 years. Exploration, excitement and experiences are what scuba diving is all about. The PADI Advanced Open Water course is designed to advance your diving, so you can start right after earning your PADI Open Water Diver certification. The course helps build confidence and expand your scuba skills through different adventure dives. You try out different specialties while gaining experience under the supervision of your Dive2go PADI Instructor. You log dives and develop capabilities as you find new ways to have fun scuba diving.

What you will learn?

You'll plan your learning path with your Dive2go instructor by choosing from a long list of Adventure Dives. There are two required dives – Deep and Underwater Navigation – you choose the other three, for a total of five dives.

- During the Deep Adventure Dive, you learn how to plan dives to deal with the physiological effects and challenges of deeper scuba diving.
- The Underwater Navigation Adventure Dive refines your compass navigation skills and helps you better navigate using kick-cycles, visual landmarks and time.
- The other knowledge and skills you get vary with your interest and the adventures you have – photography, buoyancy control, fish identification, exploring wrecks and many more.

What scuba gear will you use?

Beyond using basic scuba equipment, you'll use a compass and dive knife or dive tool. You'll also use specialized gear depending on the Adventure Dives you choose. For example, you'd obviously use a camera for the Digital Underwater Adventure Dive or a sidemount configuration during the Sidemount Adventure Dive. Your PADI Instructor will explain the equipment that you need and may suggest additional gear, such as dive light for night diving or lift bag for search and recovery diving.

What learning materials will you use?

You'll use the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver Crew-Pak, which introduces you to each of the Adventure Dives. By studying before class, you'll be better prepared for the thrill of exploring the underwater world.

What do you need to enrol in the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver course?

You must:

- A PADI Open Water Diver
- Course students over 45 years or who exceed a BMI requirement or have pre-existing medical conditions will require a dive medical prior to entering the water. Medical cost is not included in advertised prices.
- Note that qualifying certifications from other diver training organizations may apply – Contact Dive2go to discuss what option is best for you.
