

PADI OPEN WATER DIVER COURSE


What will you learn?

The PADI Open Water Diver course consists of three main phases:

- Knowledge Development (online, independent study or in a classroom) to understand basic principles of scuba diving
- Confined Water Dives to learn basic scuba skills
- Open Water Dives to use your skills and explore! The Open Water ocean dives, which there are 4 dives, can be done from the shore. However, many students choose to upgrade their dive experience with a boat trip (2 dives). Contact Dive2go to discuss what option is best for you.

How can you start learning now?

You can start learning with PADI's home-study materials – or the *Open Water Diver Manual* and *Open Water Diver Video* (a book and DVD package). What scuba gear will you use?

In the PADI Open Water Diver course, you learn to use basic scuba gear, including a mask, snorkel, fins, regulator, buoyancy control device and a tank. The equipment you wear varies, depending upon whether you're diving in tropical, temperate or cold water. Check with your Dive2go about the gear you'll use during this course.

What do you need to enrol in the PADI Open Water Diver Course?

Open Water (only) courses students over 45 years or who exceed a BMI requirement or have pre-existing medical conditions will require a dive medical prior to entering the water. Medical cost is not included in advertised prices.
