PADI RESCUE DIVER COURSE

What you will learn?

The PADI Rescue Diver course prepares you to deal with dive emergencies, minor and major, using a variety of techniques. Through knowledge development and rescue exercises, you learn what to look for and how to respond. During rescue scenarios, you put into practice your knowledge and skills. Topics include:

- Self Rescue
- Recognizing and managing stress in other divers
- Emergency management and equipment
- Rescuing panicked divers
- Rescuing unresponsive divers

What scuba gear will you use?

Along with your basic scuba equipment, you'll use additional rescue equipment like pocket masks, first aid and oxygen units.

What learning materials will you use?

You'll use the PADI Rescue Diver Crew-Pak, which introduces you to

each of the Rescue Exercises and skills. By studying before class, you'll be better prepared for the thrill of exploring the underwater world.

What do you need to enrol in the PADI Rescue Diver course?

You must:

- A PADI Advanced Open Water Diver
- Course students over 45 years or who exceed a BMI requirement or have pre-existing medical conditions will require a dive medical prior to entering the water. Medical cost is not included in advertised prices.
